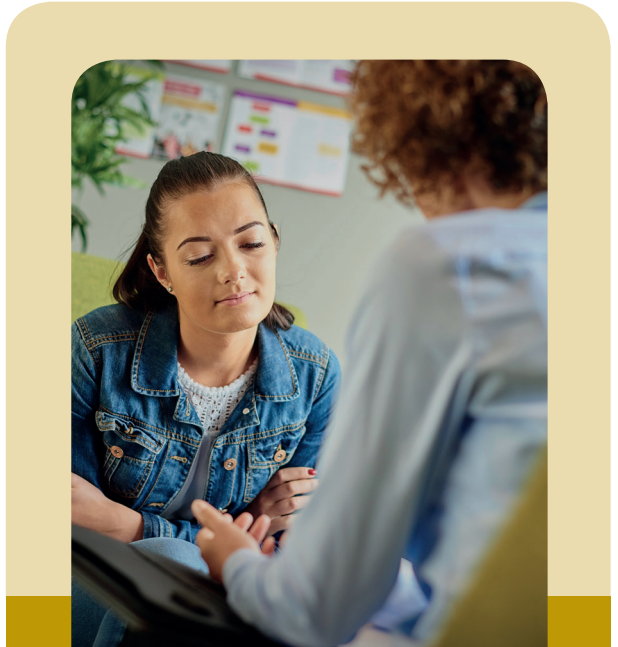


# Encounters with employers and employees
