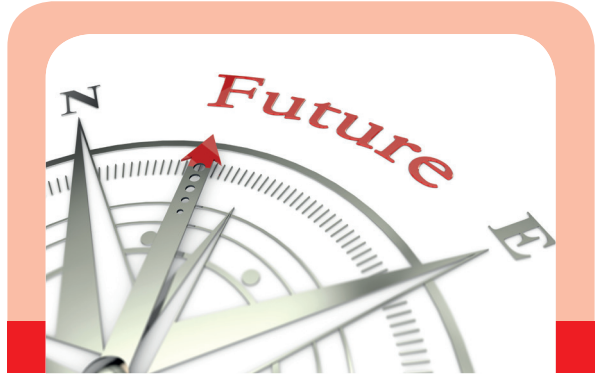

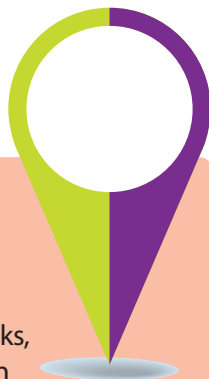
- Informative, engaging, interactive workshops for groups of KS 3 students
