YC Hertfordshire will work with you to:

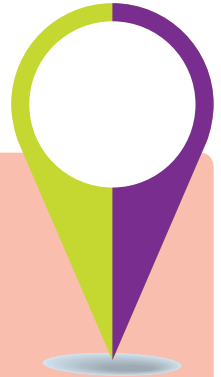
- To create a programme of the right length and content to address the specific needs for your students.

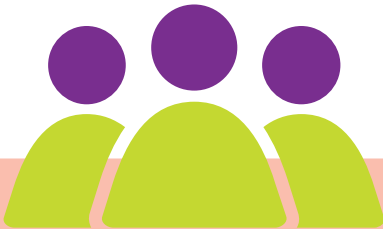


Who is benefitting?
